The WAAAM has one of the largest collections of still-flying antique airplanes and still-driving antique automobiles in the country. The “Golden Era” antique collection includes a 1917 Curtiss and collections from Aeronca, Stermann, Piper Cub, WACO and many, more. There are over 130 cars on display including a Detroit Electric, Ford Models A & T, Packards, Studebakers, a Locomobile, pickup trucks and even a few muscle cars. The museum also has motorcycles on display including Harleys, Indians, Cushman and more. This is a one-of-a-kind must-see collection. The grassy field in front of the museum has been reserved for us to park our Pontiacs along with the adjacent covered gazebo.
